The classification of Head Power Surveyor was first established in San Francisco Division in 1939. Since that time it has been recognised by Company and Union as a part of the physical bargaining unit. However, no wage rate or job definition was negotiated since it was expected that the classification would be discontinued when the original incumbent retired. Since he retired July 1, 1957, it has been determined that such classification will be needed in the future. Therefore, Company proposes to establish the classification of Head Power Surveyor with the following job definition and wage rate:

Head Power Surveyor

An employee who performs the duties of a Power Surveyor and is the lead man directing, training and checking the work of five or more Power Surveyors.

The next lower classification is Power Surveyor.

Wage rate: \$108.20 per week.
