

Dear Mr. Yochem:

The following line of progression to Service Operator Senior is in effect for East Eay Division. It is based on that shown for Test Inspectors and Mechanics where classification seniority accrues in the Serviceman's classification for bidding purposes.

Service Operator Sr.



- (5) The dual classification of Service Operator Senior-Serviceman shall be a 205.7 (a) bidder on a Service Operator Senior classification, provided he is receiving the top rate of pay as a Service Operator Senior. His seniority will be based on seniority accrued in the Serviceman's classification rather than the length of time in the dual classification.
- (6) Servicemen and dually classified Service Operators Senior-Servicemen (not at top rate of Service Operator Senior pay) shall bid equally to Service Operator Senior under 205.7(b) based on accrued seniority in the Serviceman's classification.
- (7) Servicemen and dually classified Service Operators Senior-Servicemen shall bid equally under 205.7(a) to the dual classification of Service Operator Senior-Serviceman, based on accrued seniority in the Serviceman's classification.
- (8) Apprentice Serviceman shall be considered to be the next lower classification to either Serviceman or the dual classification of Service Operator Senior-Serviceman, and when receiving top rate of pay may bid into same under 205.7(b).

This understanding will supersede and rescind the agreement on the same subject that was signed by Mr. Paul W. Yochem for the I.B.E.W., and by Mr. T. P. Jenkins for the East Bay Division on December 7, 1956.

LINE OF PROCRESSION TO SERVICE OPERATOR SERVICE

LOCAL 1245, I.B.E.W.

EAST BAY DIVISION - GAS DEPARTMENT

Persuent with Item 2, Page 14, Exhibit VI of Job Definitions, Gas Department, the following line of progression to Service Operator Senior is hereby established and becomes a supplement to said Page 14. It is based on that shown for Test Inspectors and Mechanics in that classification seniority accrues in the Servicements classification for hidding purposes.

- (5) The dual elassification of Service Operator Senior-Corvicence shall be a 205.7(a) bidder on a Service Operator Senior elassification, provided he is receiving the top rate of pay as a Service Operator Senior, His seniority will be based on contently accrued in the Servicence's elassification rather than the length of time in the dual elassification.
- (6) Servicemen and dually elastified Service Operators Senior-Servicemen (not at top rate of Service Operator Senior pay) shall bid equally to Service Operator Senior under 205.7(b) based on accrued seniority in the Servicemen's elastification.
- (7) Servicemen and dually classified Service Operators Senior-Gervicemen shall bid equally under 205.7(a) to the dual classification of Service Operator Senior-Gerviceman, based on accrued seniority in the Servicemen's classification.
- (8) Apprentice Servicemen shall be considered to be the next lower classification to either Servicemen or the dual classification of Service Operator Senior-Servicemen, and when receiving top rate of pay may bid into some under 205.7(b).

This agreement becomes effective, with no retreactivity, upon signing by representatives of the I.B.E.W. and the East Bay Division.
