Dear Mr. Dalzell:

Letter of Agreement 10-50 established the Pre-Apprentice Lineman classifications, including wage rates, for both Title 200 and Title 300 classifications. While the parties have historically agreed to a 5% differential between the same classifications in Title 200 and Title 300, this was not applied to the newly established Pre-Apprentice Lineman classifications.

In order to reflect this differential, the wage schedule for these classifications will be as follows:

	2012 Hourly Wage Rate T. 200 Pre-Apprentice Lineman (1114, 50368698)	2012 Hourly Wage Rate T. 300 Pre-Apprentice Lineman (1115, 50368700)
Start	\$23.76	\$24.95
6 months	\$27.78	\$29.17

The wage rates for Title 200 Pre-Apprentice Lineman remain the same. The modified wage rates for Title 300 Pre-Apprentice Lineman shall be effective for all new entrants into the Pre-Apprentice Lineman classification following the execution of this agreement, and as soon as the wage rates are modified in the SAP system.

This proposal has been discussed with Assistant Business Manager Joe Osterlund.
