## **PG&E EMPLOYEES HAVE CHANCE FOR TIME OFF TO WORK WITH JIMMY CARTER AT HABITAT FOR HUMANITY**

Pacific Gas & Electric has the opportunity to send up to four employees to the annual Jimmy Carter Build with Habitat for Humanity in Biloxi, Mississippi in mid-May. The lucky PG&E'ers will get to roll up their sleeves and work alongside former president Jimmy Carter to help build houses for families displaced by Hurricane Katrina.



### **How to Apply**

To be considered, submit no more than one 8 ½" x 11" sheet of paper demonstrating why you should be selected for the Habitat for Humanity volunteer build. Your submission may be in the form of a brief written statement, a collage, a photograph or any combination that best demonstrates your commitment to volunteerism and this project.

All entries must be received by April 1, 2008. Be sure to include the application cover sheet with your entry. Winners will be selected by a panel, which will include representatives from ESC, IBEW, PG&E and Habitat for Humanity. The winners will be notified by April 15th.

The selected volunteers must have the approval of their organizational leaders to attend and be able to participate for the full duration of the event from Sunday, May 11 through Friday, May 16, 2008. Habitat provides lodging and meals while on site. PG&E will provide company paid time off, roundtrip airfare from a major airport to Biloxi, and other reasonable related expenses.
