

REVIEW COMMITTEE DECISION

Review Committee File No. 1115
Sacramento Division Grievance No. 6-71-1

Subject of the Grievance

The grievance raises an issue concerning the award of a Warehouseman vacancy in Vacaville. The Division awarded the job, under the provisions of Subsection 205.7(b) to a Warehouseman bidder from Placerville. Less than six months before this the successful bidder was a Field Clerk in General Construction, having been later appointed to the Warehouseman position in Placerville after the vacancy had been posted and there were no bidders.

Discussion

The grievance questions whether Subsection 205.2(b) bars the bid of the appointee to the Vacaville vacancy. Subsection 205.2(b) provides:

"For bidding from a beginner's classification or from a classification which is considered together with a beginner's classification as noted in Title 600, a regular employee who has transferred from one Line of Progression to another shall not be entitled to consideration under the preferential sequence of Subsections 205.7(b) and (c) until he has worked a combined total of 6 months in such classifications in the line of progression to which he transferred."

In this case the employee is bidding from Warehouseman to Warehouseman. As such he is not bidding from a "beginner's classification." For this reason, the six months' bar is not applicable.

Decision

The job award was proper.
