Dear Mr. Dalzell:

The Company and Union discussed the current business need to attract qualified Troublemens, even for temporary assignments, within the Bay Area. The parties agree to temporarily expand the premium eligibility provided under Letter of Agreement 19-17-PGE, to employees temporarily assigned to a Troublemans classification (includes: Transmission Troublemans – 50010431 and Troublemans – 50010432). To be eligible, a Troublemans on temporary assignment must be assigned to a location covered under LA 19-17-PGE and will be eligible for the corresponding premium (either 22% or 10% as applicable under LA 19-17-PGE).

This agreement will expire on April 30, 2020, unless mutually agreed upon in writing.
